Swine Flu Update

As you well know, there has been a lot of reporting on the H1N1 Virus (a.k.a. "Swine Flu") in the news media. As this flu virus spreads, we thought it would be a good idea to share the information we received from the Santa Clara County Public Health Office.

What are the symptoms of Swine Flu?

- o Fever 100° or higher
- o Head and body aches
- o Sore throat
- o Vomiting and/or Diarrhea
- o Chills
- o Trouble breathing
- o Cough

What should I do if I think I am sick?

- If you have a fever of 100°F or higher and one of the symptoms listed above, call your doctor or medical provider.
- If you're sick - stay home from work or school. It is important to limit contact with other people, so you don't spread germs to others.
- If you have flu symptoms and need to go to a medical appointment, use a surgical mask or cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you sneeze or cough, and throw the tissue in the trash afterward.
